Aim of Volunteering Role	To visit people in their own home to help relieve social isolation
Object of the Volunteering Role	To visit people at home who may be housebound or live alone, and ensuring that they are receiving any other services that they may need. In addition all volunteers are asked to help at one fundraising event a year.
Tasks	 To visit service user(s) weekly on an agreed day and time. To help them go for a short walk or to the local shop if this is required. To identify any further needs they may have and with their permission pass this information on to the Project Co-ordinator to action. To liaise with Project Co- ordinator.
Time	Volunteers are welcome to spend a minimum of 3 months initially with us, but longer if you are able to. It is preferred that you commit to a minimum of two hours per week or fortnight. Training will not exceed the time commitment agreed.

Place of work	Dependent upon the location of the service user, but within easy travelling distance.
